The role of product performance in establishing markets via building code approvals is discussed and a summary of current code approvals in the industry is assembled. Potential new markets available to the replacement panel types are described. On the basis of technological, economic, political, and market arguments, a forecast for the future of the U.S. structural panels business is presented as it was reported in 1981.
