Singularly enough, almost over the Cuckoo s bower, near the top of a white birch sapling was a nest of the Rose-breasted Grosbeak containing three eggs. The Marsh Hawk s nest I took up bodily from the ground and with a friend in front to hold back the brush, we got it safely outside, thence across the lots to the wagon, and it now occupies a respectable niche in my cabinet. It is a poorly constructed affair, but quite bulky and is by far the largest nest of any ground builder in this section. The Grosbeak s nest was up eighteen feet, nearly on a slender sapling which wou d not sustain my weight; but by holding three of the chump of white birches together I contrived to ascend. The nest of the Rosebreasted Grosbeak is small for so large a bird, and the eggs are appreciably larger than...
