

This eminently national art consists in the assembling of feathers of varying sizes and hues in patterns suggested by the artisans' taste. Such work could never have been undertaken outside of the zone of tropical forests--the lair of birds of gorgeous plumage. Hummingbirds, characterized by the metallic brilliance of their feathers, and gaudily colored parrots were systematically exploited for their...
