To bring up to date the whole question of moral offenses, some parts of which have taken on a singularly different aspect since Tardieu's classical and original work, and to create familiarity with the whole question of the perversions of the sexual instinct, a question almost denied yesterday, and still unknown to the majority of physicians and students despite its triple interest, clinical, psychological and medicolegal. Several motives influenced me in undertaking the translation of this work, - a privilege that Dr. Thoinot immediately accorded me when I broached the matter to him, and for which satisfactory arrangements were later made with the French publishers.
